3. Members will not aim to damage the reputation of any other training organisation, trainer and assessor through humiliation or any other way that will have a negative impact on that party
4. Members will hold the highest respect for their colleagues and industry organisations
5. Members will make it their business to report any other member or non-member to the association for unethical practice or anything else that can cause damage to the professional standard expected by the industry
6. Members are expected to work collaboratively with others in sharing their experience and knowledge to professionally improve the industry
7. Members using S.T.A resources will do so with respect and will comply with the licence agreement
8. Member RTO's and Trainer's will not disrespect or discriminate students in any way (i.e. culture, religion, sexual choice, gender, pregnancy etc)
