





ACCESSING YOUR LESSONS

To access your first lesson, click on 'Induction to Security'

You will now see two headings - Lesson and Materials

- Lesson is all lessons documents that are needed to pass the quiz
- Materials include any resource documents that will help in understanding the lesson content or to act as an example.

Once you have finished the lesson please click '**Mark Complete**' and this will take you to your next lesson. Alternatively you can click 'Back to Course' to return to your dashboard.

TAKING A QUIZ

At the end of each lesson is one or more quizzes that need to be taken. To access simply click on the first quiz. For example, Cluster 1 - Knowledge Assessment.

The quiz will open automatically with one question per page. Once you have answered the question click on 'NEXT' to see the next question.

Once you complete the assessment you will be see your score, and if you have not passed you will have an opportunity to retake the quiz up to 2 times.

QUIZ QUESTION TYPES

You may encounter a number of different question types whilst undertaking the quiz. These include:

1. Single Choice - Single choice means there is **only one correct answer**.

What are contemporaneous notes? Tick the correct response.

Contemporaneous Notes are notes made at the time or shortly after an event occurs.

Contemporaneous Notes are notes made at the conclusion of an event

Contemporaneous Notes are notes prepared for use in court.

2. Multi Choice - Multiple choice questions **may have multiple correct answers**. In order for the question to be marked correct, you must select **ALL** of the correct answers (this may be one or multiple).

Records and reports maybe used for legal purposes. Let's assume there was a fight at a protest. Police now need footage and reports. You have to write a report, what information would you apply in a formal incident report let alone your security officer note book? Choose the 6 critical pieces of information required in your report.

3. Free Choice - There are no options available to select, you must write the correct word or words for a correct answer. For example:

Question: What colour is the sun?

Answer: Yellow (note that capitalisation is ignored)

4. Fill in the blank - These questions allow you to insert a word or words in the middle of a sentence or paragraph. You are scored by typing the correct answer into this empty field. For this field please type in the full word (including when there is a letter prior to the field).

$10 - 5 = 5$

$8 - 4 = 4$

$3 - 2 = 1$

$6 - 6 = 0$

5. Short Answer - This question type requires an essay/written response that will be reviewed by an assessor.
